## Scooter Park Steps Forward To Serve House Dist. 65



“Scooter” Park, a 4th generation cattleman and farmer, filed his candidacy papers on April 9th at the Oklahoma State Capitol. Park noted that rural Oklahoma is forgotten at times, and our interests are ignored, as Oklahoma City and D.C. create regulations that cause harm to our way of life.

Scooter has been a constant presence in community activities and service, in addition to a 35-year businessman and employer in Cotton County. He began with saving to buy 160 acres, developing the land while working extra hours and odd jobs to earn money to buy more land, building his farming and ranching operation over many years to its current several thousand acres, all through hard work and determination.

Scooter has been a longtime regular volunteer at the Devol Fire Department, has spent countless hours voluntarily flying surveillance for the

Cotton County Sheriff’s Department, is CLEET certified, and served as a reserve deputy for Tillman County. His wife Lisa is a teacher’s aide at Big Pasture Public Schools. Scooter is former president of the Cotton County Farm Bureau, member of the National Federation of Independent Business, lifetime member of the NRA (National Rifle Association), member of the Oklahoman Cattleman’s Association, and a member of the American Farmer & Ranchers. He and his wife, Lisa Park, and their four children Jeron, Marissa, Meredith, & Allison have been active in their home church of First Baptist of Grandfield. Committed to helping youth baseball, the FFA chapters, and understanding the cornerstone of the fabric that makes up a community, Scooter believes his faith to Christ and his family share the fundamental principles of a strong community.

Scooter has a long held belief that he has put into action in support of rural Oklahoma, determined that future generations will have opportunities right at home in our district to grow industry, success, and investment. Scooter will ensure our area will have a strong voice in the direction of the entire state of Oklahoma.
